

Not Allowed in Venue

The following is a non-exclusive list of what You may NOT bring, or have another person bring on Your behalf, into the Event:

- NO Air Horns
- NO Animals
- NO Audio Recording Devices
- NO AVPs, Mods, Liquid Refills for Vapes
- NO Coolers
- NO Cameras (Professional)
- NO Detachable Lens / No DSLRs
- NO Discriminative or appropriative items
- NO Divisive symbols or inappropriate imagery
- NO Drones or Remote-Control Vehicles or Toys
- NO Drugs or Drug Paraphernalia
 - Incl. Cannabis, Cannabis Products
 - Prescriptions must be in properly labeled containers that match the holder's ID. (No pillboxes.)
- NO Flammables
 - Incl. Fireworks, Explosives, Road Flares
- NO Flags or Totems
- NO Flashlight
- NO Glass, Metal, Aluminum or Steel Containers
 - Incl. Refillable Water Bottles
- NO Glow Sticks, LED Gloves, or LED Products
- NO Musical Instruments
- NO Outside Food or Beverage
- NO Weapons of Any Kind
 - Guns, Ammo, Pocket Knives, Tasers, Pepper Spray/Mace, etc.
 - Including off-duty law enforcement or concealed carry permits.
- NO item that can be used as a means to disturb the peace, endanger the safety of the crowd and/or inflict damage to people and goods in the sole discretion of Event staff.

Allowed In Venue

You may bring the following objects to the Event

- YES Backpacks, Purses, Handbags, Totes, Fanny Packs

- YES Blankets (Small) & Beach Towels
- YES Cameras
 - Detachable lens cameras are not allowed.
- YES Dancing Shoes
- YES Ear Plugs

- YES Hand Sanitizer and Baby Wipes
- YES Hats
- YES Lip Balm
- YES Makeup
- YES Parasols
- YES Phones and Chargers
- YES Sunscreen.
- YES Sunglasses
- YES Water Bottles
 - No Metal or Glass

PUBLIC SAFETY

- Security and safety are of utmost importance. We work hand in hand with law enforcement and public safety agencies to help ensure the safety of our Event. Because of those very same concerns, we are unable to publicly comment on detailed, specific actions which are taken. Some of the security measures you will notice upon your arrival such as bag checks, walk-through metal detectors (magnetometers) for all attendees, staff and performers, and dog sweeps.
- Please note that we will implement searches upon Event entry. Please arrive early and note the Prohibited Items list, these will be confiscated / surrendered upon entry.
- In the event of an emergency, information may be relayed on the video screens, over the audio system, and/or through mobile notifications.

- If you, or a friend, require medical assistance please locate your nearest medical tent or alert a staff member.
- And remember: if you see something, say something. Flag down any staff member if you notice something that doesn't seem quite right.
